### Financial Obligations

Team members have financial obligations that must be fulfilled in order to participate in monthly practices, scheduled competitions, clinics, and championships. Below is a comprehensive list of obligations for the upcoming season.

#### Monthly Tuition (Effective June 1<sup>st</sup> 2019, runs through May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020)

**\*\*Our tuition is DISCOUNTED for families who pay by the 22<sup>nd</sup> of each month.**

**\*\*AFTER the 22<sup>nd</sup>, the price raises to REGULAR pricing, and is automatically updated in iClassPro.**

#### Policy

- Tuition is paid monthly, due on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of the previous month. For example, October tuition is due on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of September.
- All tuition is non-refundable.
- We offer DISCOUNTED pricing for ALL of our members. If tuition is not received by the 22<sup>nd</sup>, regular tuition pricing goes into effect. (See Regular Pricing Chart).
- After the 1<sup>st</sup>, your son will not be permitted to practice until tuition is settled.
- Payments can be made in cash, or a check made payable to "Paragon."
- Tuition is usually adjusted in May, following the end of the regular competitive season. Typically it is raised between 1 and 3% per year.

#### Special Notes

- We do not offer refunds for any reason (no exceptions.)
- We do not offer tuition adjustments (missed days, late practice arrival/early departure, multiple siblings, summer vacations.)

#### Tuition Calculation

- Tuition is calculated yearly, and then divided equally into 12 payments (June-May). This takes into account any missed practices due to competition travel, clinics, National Congress', Holidays, shorter months, and longer months. This also takes into account at least one vacation week during the summer.
- **Your tuition is based on your son's group, not the number of practices attended per week.** (I.e If your son missed 1-2x a week for school, other sports, etc. there will not be a pro-rated tuition offered.)

### **Coach(es) Assessment Fees\*\*\***

Your coaches assessment fees are collected (5) times a year, and help pay for the following:

- Coaches Travel (to and from competition)
- Coaches Hotel / Airfare / Mileage / Rental Car
- Coaches Session Fee
- Coaches & Athlete Clinic(s)
- Any new material released by USA Gymnastics at the start of the quadrennium (i.e. Coaches Manual, Training DVD, etc.)
- Coaches Congress, USA Championships

Assessments are spread evenly throughout ALL families with competitive team members. If you have more than one son in the program, you will have to pay assessment dues for each son.

The final assessment can be adjusted following the end of the regular season (Regionals), in order to budget for both National Championships and USA Championships. Once adjusted, that assessment is typically billed in June.

*Please note that if your son discontinues with his competitive experience during the season, your family will be responsible for any remaining assessment payments before the account will be settled.*

## Meet Payments ++

### Policy

- Meet Payments are released via e-mail and will include the entry fee of your athlete, plus any applicable team entry fees.
- Typically they are released much earlier in the season, to ensure a prompt entry into meets that have early deadlines for discounts, or for attendance.
- All athletes are entered into a competition that has been scheduled and will be responsible for meet expenses UNLESS Coach Kevin is notified in writing 30 days before the due date.++
- Payments are non refundable, unless a documented illness or medical reason is accepted by the HOST club.

### ++Special Notes:

- Compulsory Level Athletes in Division 2 are NOT REQUIRED to attend INVITATIONAL Competitions throughout the season. They are only required to attend the three Designated Qualifiers and State Championships, highlighted in RED below.
- All other athletes (Compulsory Levels 5-7, 9-10, JDO) are expected to attend all scheduled competitions.
